**FRI 12 MAR 10 - EDGE OF DARKNESS** – Ray Winstone, Mel Gibson – Thomas is a veteran homicide detective for the Boston Police Department and a single father. When his only child, 24-year-old Emma, is murdered on the steps of his home, everyone assumes that he was the target. But he suspects otherwise and embarks on a mission to find out about his daughter's secret life and her killing. His investigation leads him into a dangerous looking-glass world of corporate cover-ups, government collusion and murder. Rated R (strong bloody violence and language) 117 MINS

**SAT 13 MAR 10 – THE TOOTH FAIRY** – Ashley Judd, Dwayne Johnson – Derek Thompson, is a hard-charging hockey player whose nickname comes from his habit of separating opposing players from their biscuspids. When Derek discourages a youngster's dreams, he's sentenced to one week's hard labor as a real tooth fairy, complete with the requisite tutu, winds and magic wand. At first, Derek "can't handle the tooth" – bumbling and stumbling as he tries to furtively wing his way through strangers' homes-doing what tooth fairies do. But as Derek slowly adapts to his new position, he begins to rediscover his own forgotten dreams. Rated PG (mild language, some rude humor and sports action) 102 MINS

**SAT 13 MAR 10 – THE LOVELY BONES** – Mark Wahlberg, Rachel Weisz – The lovely bones centers on a young girl who has been murdered and watches over her family and her killer from heaven. She must weigh her desire for vengeance against her desire for her family to heal. Rated PG-13 (mature thematic material involving disturbing violent content and images, and some language) 135 MINS

**FRI 19 MAR 10 – FROM PARIS WITH LOVE** – John Travolta, Jonathan Rhys Meyers – A personal aide to the U.S. Ambassador in France, James Reece has an enviable life in Paris, but his real passion is his side job as a low-level operative for the CIA. When he's offered his first senior-level assignment, he can't believe his good luck until he meets his new partner, special agent Charlie Wax . A trigger-happy, wisecracking, loose cannon who's been sent to Paris to stop a terrorist attack. Wax leads James on a white-knuckle shooting spree through the Parisian underworld. But when James discovers he's a target of the same crime ring they're to bust, he realizes there's no turning back. And that Wax himself might be his only hope for making it through the next forty-eight hours alive. Rated R (strong bloody violence throughout, drug content, pervasive language and brief sexuality) 92 MINS

**SAT 20 MAR 10 – THE WOLFMAN** - Simmon Merrells, Gemma Whelan - Lawrence Talbot's childhood ended the night his mother died. After he left the sleepy Victorian hamlet of Blackmoor, he spent decades recovering and trying to forget. But when his brother's fiancée tracks him down to help find her missing love, Talbot returns home to join the search. He learns that something with brute strength and insatiable bloodlust has been killing the villagers. As he pieces together the gory puzzle, he hears of an ancient curse that turns the afflicted into werewolves when the moon is full. Now, if he has any chance at ending the slaughter and protecting the woman he has grown to love, Talbot must destroy the vicious creature in the woods surrounding Blackmoor. But as he hunts for the nightmarish beast, a simple man with a tortured past will uncover a primal side to himself...one he never imagined existed. Rated R (bloody horror violence and gore) 102 MINS

**FRI 26 MAR 10 – DEAR JOHN** - Channing Tatum, Amanda Seyfied - The story of John Tyree, a young soldier home on leave, and Savannah Curtis, the idealistic college student he falls in love with during her spring vacation. Over the next seven tumultuous years, the couple is separated by John's increasingly dangerous deployments. While meeting only sporadically, they stay in touch by sending a continuous stream of love letters overseas—correspondence that eventually triggers fateful consequences. Rated PG-13 (some sensuality and violence) 108 MINS

**SAT 27 MAR 10 – VALENTINE'S DAY** – Julia Roberts, Bradley Cooper – Intertwining couples and singles in Los Angeles break-up and make-up based on the pressures and expectations of Valentine's Day. Rated PG-13 (some sexual material and brief partial nudity) 125 MINS
