JB Charleston Commander's Cup events start Sept. 17

As part of the activities leading up to the Oct. 1 FOC (Fully Operational Capability) date for the joining of Charleston AFB with Naval Weapons Station Charleston to become Joint Base Charleston, there will be special **Commander's Cup** recreational events starting on Sept. 17. These events include a golf tournament at Wrenwoods Golf Course, basketball tournaments at both bases, a volleyball tournament at the Air Base Fitness Center and a bowling tournament at Marrington Lanes Bowling Center on the Weapons Station. The finale will be held on Oct. 1, which will consist of three events – a three-person running relay, one-person bike sprint from the Air Base to the Weapons Station, and a two-person swim relay.

The unit that receives the most points by participating in the JBCCC events will capture the "Commander's Cup" and will earn the right to be called the "Joint Base Charleston Champions". Units will appoint a "Team Captain" that will act as the team liaison to the JBCCC staff and unit participating. Unit rosters will consist of participants for each event, alternates that can be used to substitute and volunteers. Team members may participate in one or all events whenever possible.

Deadline to enter the golf tournament is Sept. 10. All other events have a Sept. 13 entry deadline. Completion of Federal Cards and Public School Funding

Each year Charleston, Dorchester and Berkeley County School Districts conduct a pupil survey to count how many students are "federally connected." The school system is paid by the federal government in lieu of property taxes based on the number of "federally connected" students. Since Federal properties are exempt from local taxation, the assistance received helps to replace local taxes required for operating schools and constructing school buildings.

Collection of this information is required by Federal regulations. It is important that federally connected parents complete the form for every pupil in area schools whether or not the parent or guardian is living or working on Federal property. Upon completion please ensure your child return it to his/her teacher. The information provided will be kept strictly confidential. Beginning climbers will be harnessed by the instructor and climbing will be supervised at all times. The cost of the introductory climb is only \$2.00. Once you get the hang of it, you'll want to purchase an hourly climbing pass or a daily pass. This will allow you to climb as many times as you wish in the allotted time frame and to experiment with all the climbing routes.

Climbing to the Next Level

More experienced climbers will want to take advantage of our Auto Belay Certification Program, which allows qualified applicants to hook and unhook themselves from the harness without assistance. This gives climbers the freedom to climb without having to wait for the availability of a climbing instructor. Simply, check in at the front desk, and up you go!
